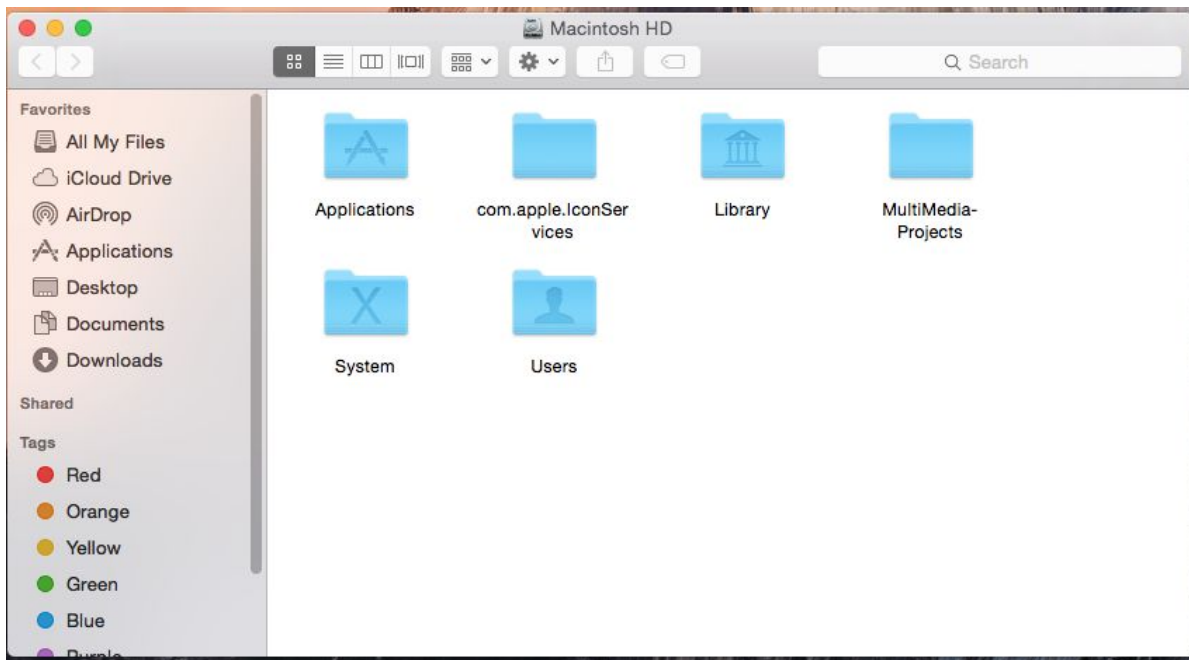


Using Garage Band

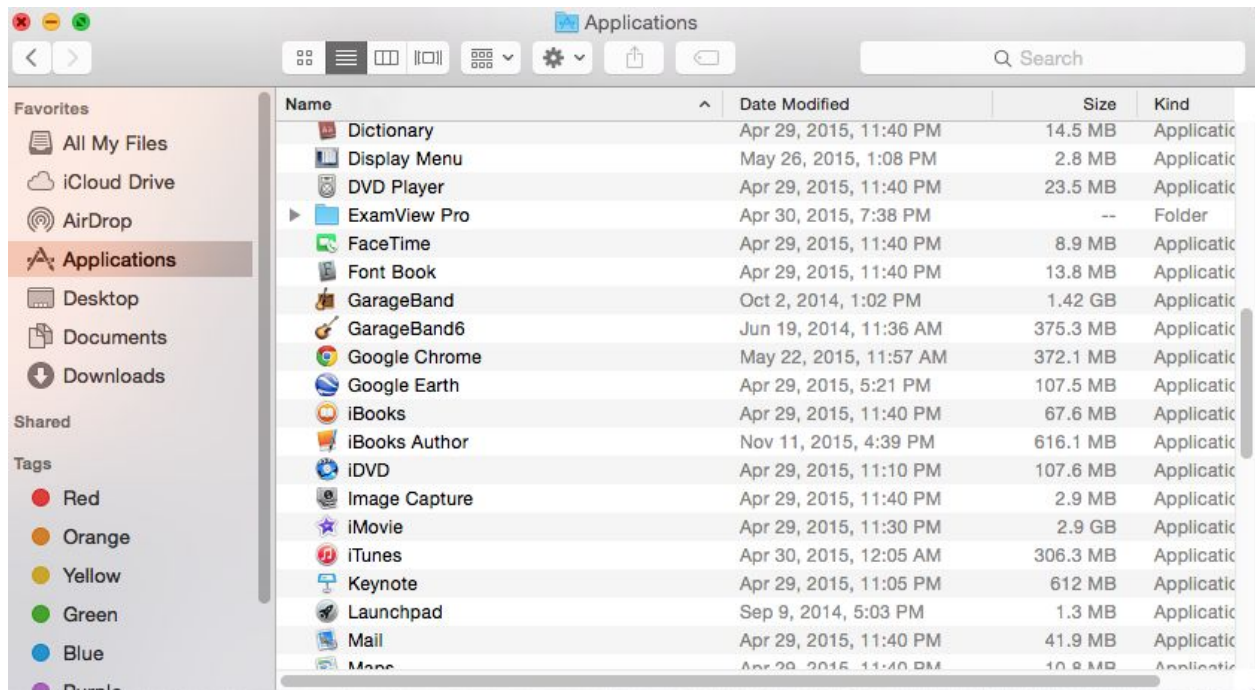
1. Log in to the MAC and Launch Garage Band by double clicking on the Macintosh HD icon.



2. Click on the Applications Folder



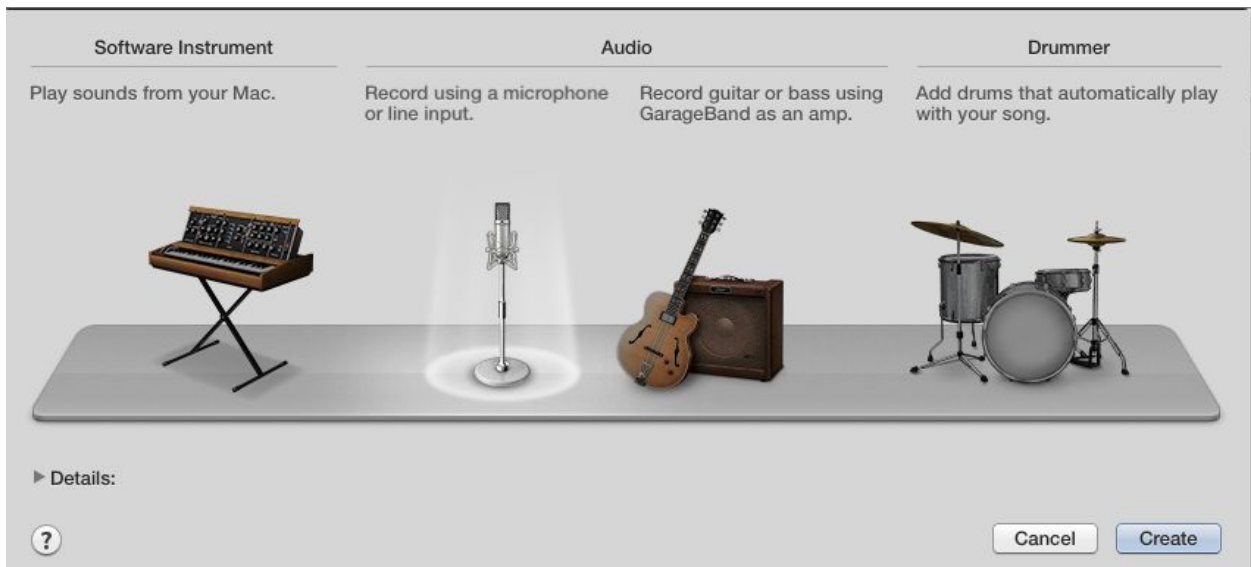
3. Select GarageBand



4. Select Empty Project

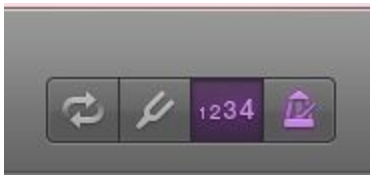


5. Under Audio, Select: “Record Using a Microphone or Line Input.” Click on Create.

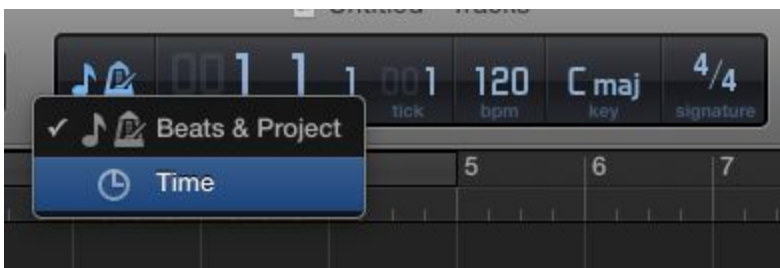


6. Make sure that:

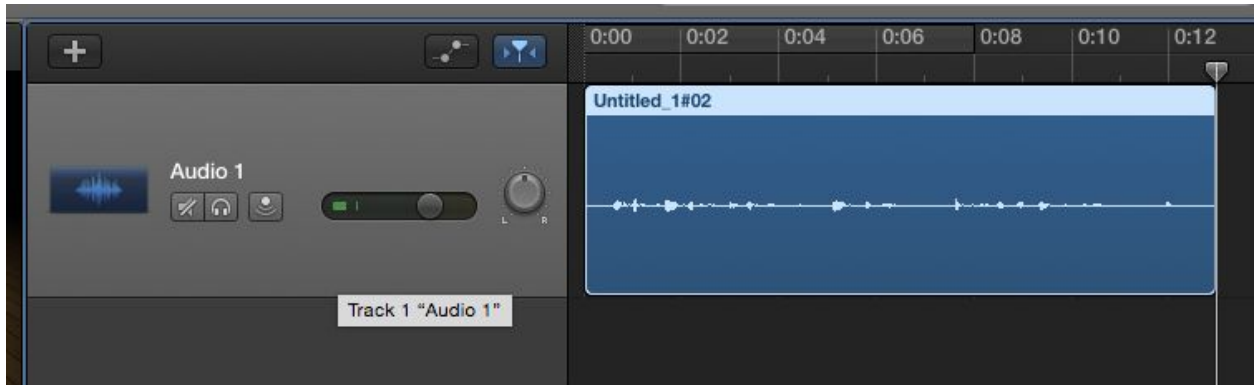
The Metronome is deselected.



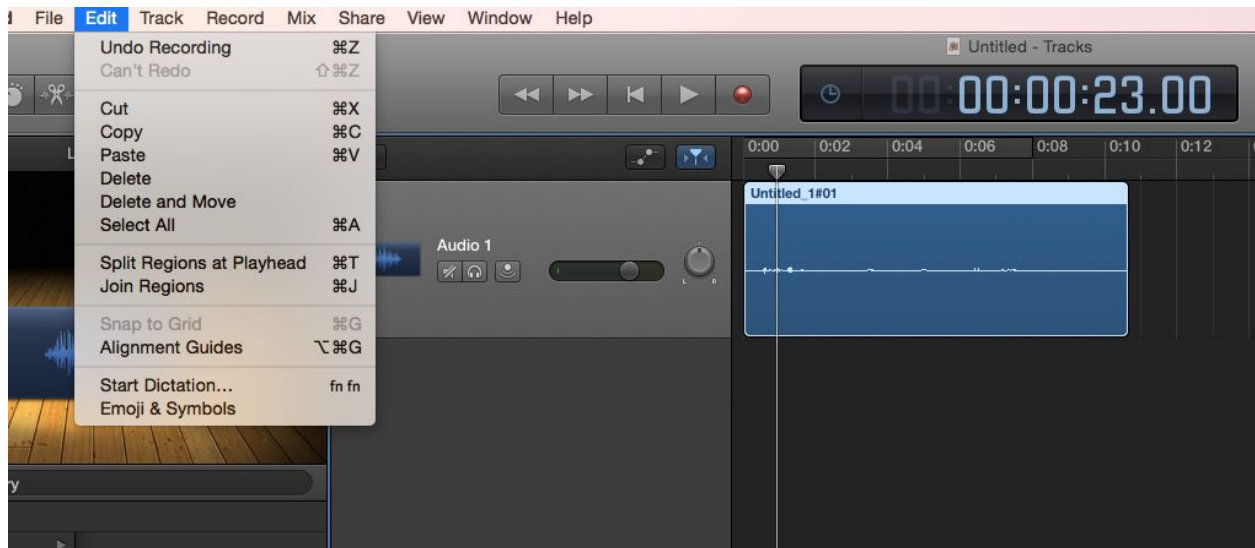
The Display Mode is set to Time



7. Press the Red Dot to Begin Recording.



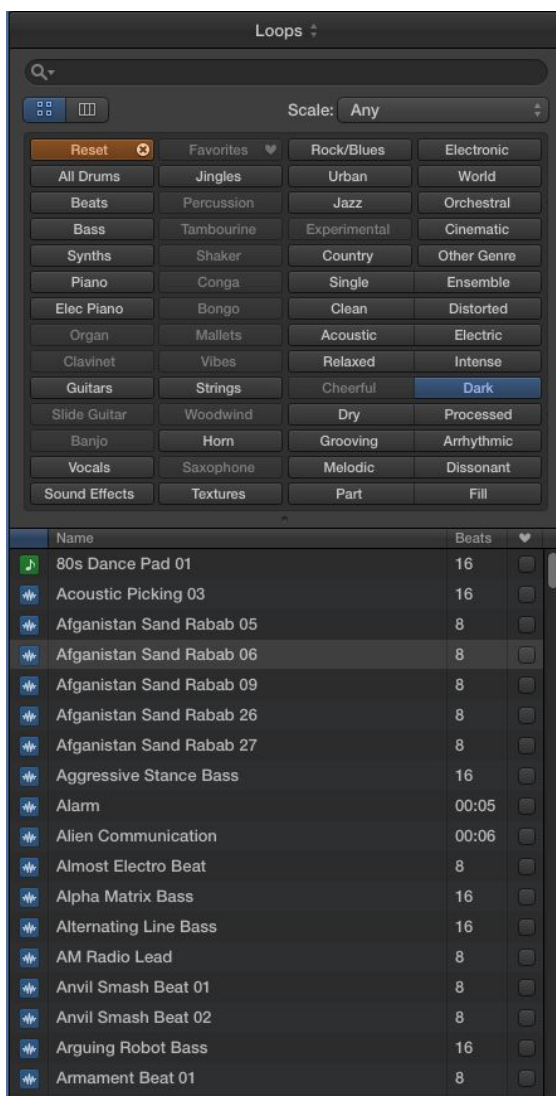
8. Refine Your Recording by Trimming Your Audio Line for a Clean Start and Finish. Delete Unwanted Portions of your Recording.



9. On the Far Right-Hand Side of the Garage Band Display, Click on the Loops Icon.



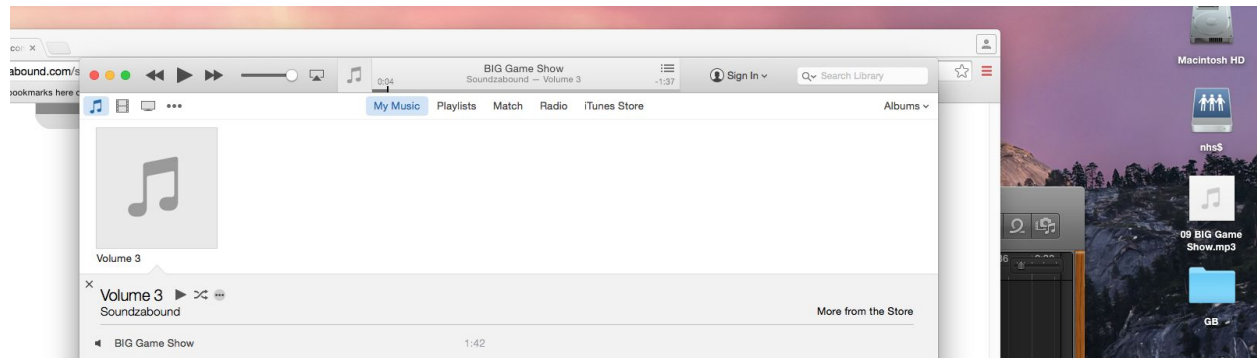
10. Select Loops/Sound Tracks that Will Enhance Your Presentation. You Can Use the Search Feature to find Pertinent Sound Effects. Drag the Loops Under Your Audio Line.



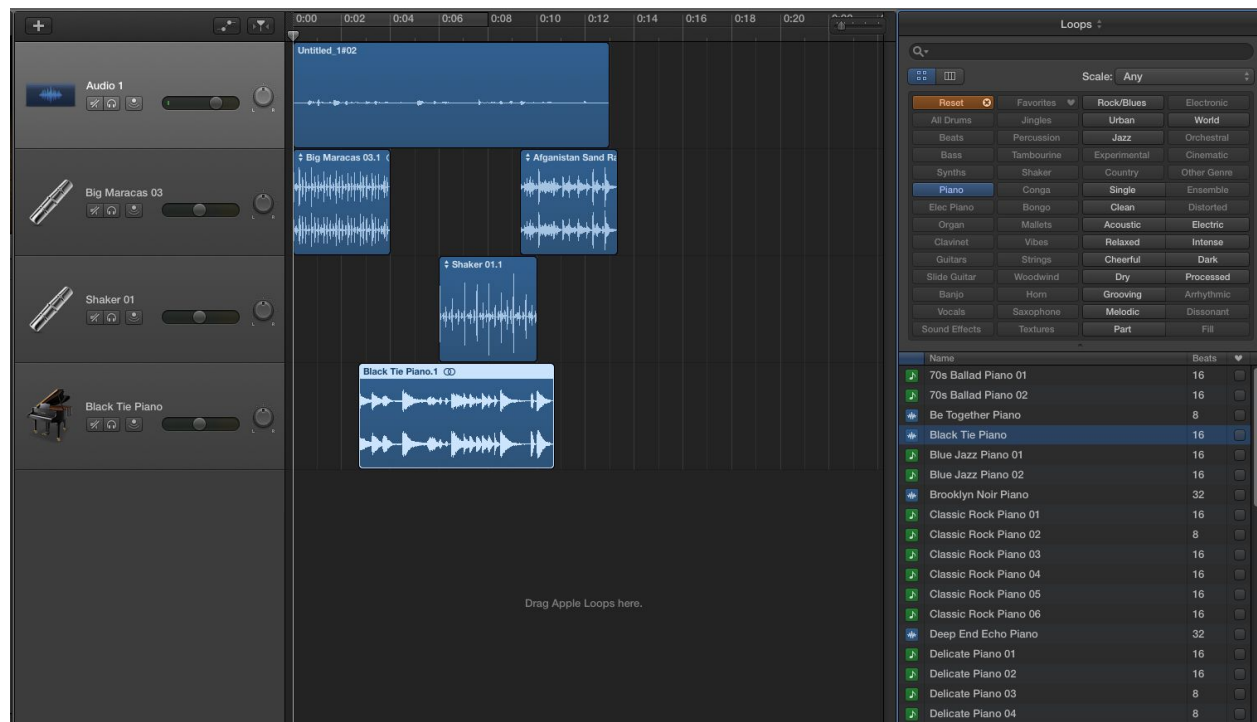
11. You May Also Upload Mp3's from Outside Sources, including those from Soundzabound, a Subscription Service that Ensures You are Copyright Compliant. Get the Password from the Librarians. Save the Desired Mp3 Sounds to Your Computer's Desktop. Enter these sounds by dragging them from the Desktop to Under The Audio Line in Garage Band.

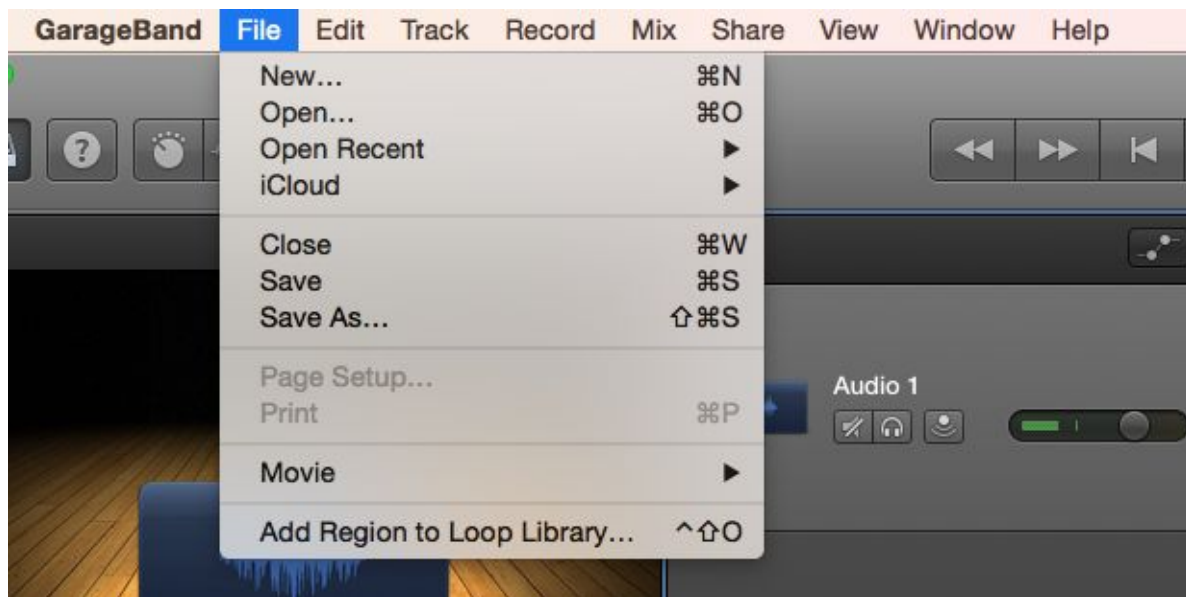
The Download will Go Into i-Tunes. Drag it Onto the Desktop.



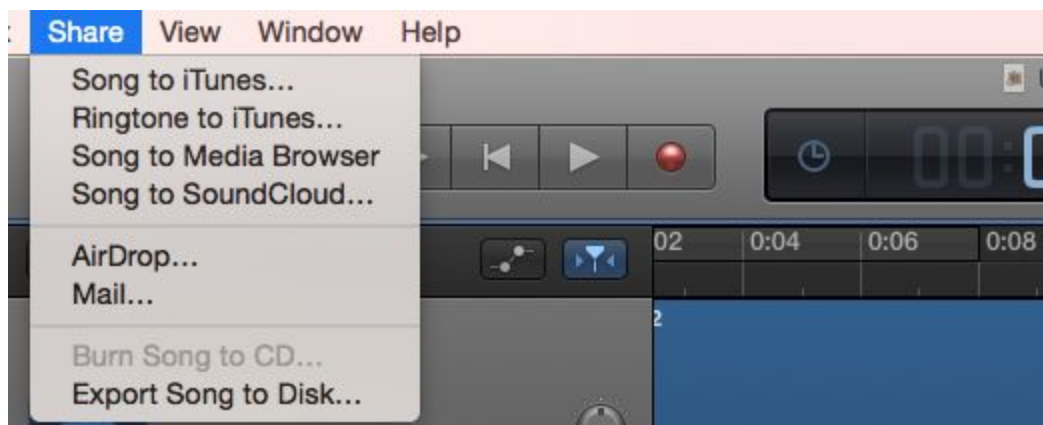
12. Adjust Your Sounds to Match Underneath Your Audio Track by Adjusting Timing and Volume.



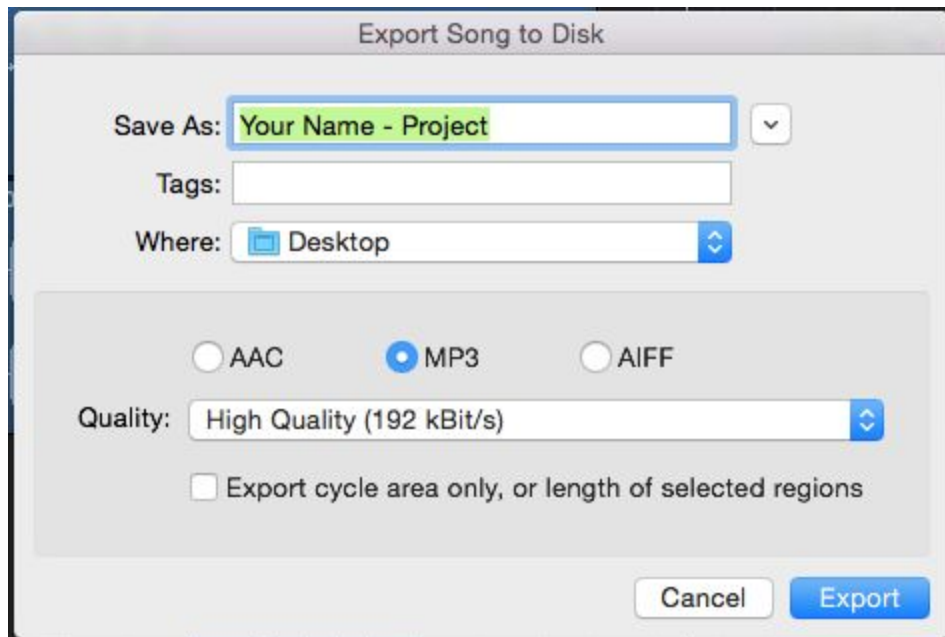
13. Save. (If You Haven't Already!)
